Solar Training for the Experienced Worker NABCEP PhotoVoltaic Entry-Level Prep Course

This program is designed to assist individuals with a strong background in electrical systems to gain certification in the solar photovoltaic (pv) field. This intensive training will run 20 hours. It will prepare participants to sit for the North American Board of Certified Energy Practitioners (NABCEP) PV Entry Level Exam.



COURSE OVERVIEW:

- Class Information will be compact and fast-paced.
- Learning Objectives outlined by NABCEP will be covered, followed by a examination review session.
- Participants will gain a basic level of electrical knowledge and a general understanding of Photovoltaics terminology and concepts.
- Certificate of Completion for PV Entry Level Prep Course will be granted to those who participate in class and pass the two hour, 60 question exam.

- Knowledge of general safety procedures when working with electrical systems
