CLIMATE ACTION STRATEGIES & ENVIRONMENTAL PRIORITIES

Monday, January 25, 1–2 pm

Past choices have affected Maryland's environment and have climate impacts. Hear a summary from local legislators of potential policy solutions to meet clean energy and carbon reduction goals to address environmental priorities.

LEVERAGING INVESTMENT & ADVANCING CLEAN ENERGY INNOVATION

We'll focus on MCEC's future funding, opportunities for Green Banks, and Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) Legislation.

RESPONSE STRATEGIES FOR THE MINIMUM OFFER PRICE RULE (MOPR)

Monday, February 8, 1–2 pm

The current FERC order directs the PJM Interconnection to expand its Minimum Offer Price Rule to most of the state-subsidized capacity resources. The order will significantly impact the capacity market which serves Maryland ratepayers. How will regulators and utilities find common ground in responding to the order? What is FRR and how will it affect the FERC order?

TRANSPORTATION ELECTRIFICATION

Monday, February 22, 1–2 pm

The Transportation & Climate Initiative (TCI) is a regional collaboration of 12 Northeast and Mid-Atlantic states and the District of Columbia that seeks to improve transportation, develop the clean energy economy, and reduce carbon emissions from the transportation sector. SESSION WRAP-UP REPORT OF CLEAN ENERGY SECTOR STATUS UPDATES


Monday, April 19, 1–2 pm
